Cancellation Policy:

Clients who do not give written notice 72 hours in advance of the cancellation or shortening of their dog(s) duration of stay at Seneca Pet Care LLC will be required to pay 50% of the total reservation amount on cancelled day(s) unless Seneca Pet Care LLC at their discretion, can fill the vacancy created by your dog(s) absence. Reservations are preferred for all stays. Last minute boarding can occasionally be accommodated. Clients who have failed to cancel 72 hours ahead will be asked to pay for their dog(s) stay in advance for future stays or requests may be declined.

Authorized Pickup:

By checking here, you agree that you may verbally (by telephone) or in writing (by facsimile or otherwise) request that Seneca Pet Care LLC release your dog to someone other than the person(s) listed above, and you release Seneca Pet Care LLC of and from any and all responsibility for releasing your dog to any person Seneca Pet Care LLC believes to be authorized by you.

Seneca Pet Care's Policies:

- All reservations are subject to Seneca Pet Care LLC discretion, and all reservations can be denied for any reason.
- Seneca Pet Care cannot guarantee that toys, blankets, or beds will be kept in the same condition as brought in. For safety reasons, tennis balls and rawhide are NOT allowed.
- All dogs must have written proof of full and current vaccinations per their veterinarian's recommendations, currently treated for ectopic parasites (fleas etc.) & internal parasites (hooks, whips, and roundworms) and be over 4 months of age. Special exceptions for younger puppies can be discussed with Seneca Pet Care LLC per Janelle Kaiser.
- Owners must certify that their dog is in good health and has not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days or provide certification of health from their veterinarian. Pets who are coughing, have active ocular/nasal discharge or sneezing (any symptoms of upper respiratory illness) may not be admitted. Dogs must be free of external parasites and appear to be in good physical condition. If the dog is found to have ectopic parasites, treatment will be initiated immediately and owner will be billed accordingly. All dogs must be spayed or neutered unless special arrangements are made for breeding, show dogs, or puppies whom have not been altered to promote the best outcome for orthopedic health (large and giant breeds).
- Challenging unaltered males (as determined by Seneca Pet Care LLC) and bitches (unaltered female) in season (estrus) will be charged \$10.00 extra per day to accommodate their special needs and requirements. Owners of these pets must make special arrangements with Seneca Pet Care LLC per Janelle Kaiser.

- We allow dogs from the same household to share a kennel suite. Additional dogs- \$20.00/day for each additional dog sharing appropriately sized suites.
- For safety reasons, we generally do not accept dogs under 25 lbs.
- All dogs must have an identification tag with a phone number or address of the owner. We recommend that the tag include the dog's name. All dogs must be on a leash when entering or leaving the premises.
- Seneca Pet Care LLC reserves the right to determine which room houses your dog. In the event that a dog is destructive in one of the suites, Seneca Pet Care LLC will move it to a more destruction-proof kennel for the safety of your pet and our other guests. Owners agree to compensate Seneca Pet Care LLC for replacement cost of any furniture, housing, or facility material destroyed by their pet.
- There is a \$4 per day charge when feeding your dog with "house" food/diet (Purina ProPlan).
NOTE: We recommend that you bring in your own food since changing a dog's food can cause a severe upset stomach.
- Each meal should be pre-portioned in individual sealed baggies or bagged in gallon zip-lock bags and labeled. We will not accept containers of food for any stay less than 10 days.
- Reservations are required for boarding.
- Pick-up and drop-off times must be scheduled in advance and can occur anytime between 9 a.m. – 12 noon EST and 3 p.m. - 7 p.m. EST. Pick-ups after 12 noon are charged for that day's stay.
- No pick-up or drop-off is available for the following dates: Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve, and New Year's Day.
- We offer a long-term boarding discount of 10% off for stays exceeding 15 days. This discount may not be combined with any other special offer or discounted rate. Long term boarding over 30 days is discounted 20%.
- Dog owner understands the risks involved with communal boarding of dogs. Our boarding dogs play both outside and inside with other dogs. Although we will offer reasonable care, the unpredictable personality of dogs can sometimes lead to injury. Dog owner agrees that any problem that develops with their dog will be treated as deemed best by Seneca Pet Care LLC and full financial responsibility for any and all expenses will be assumed by the dog owner.
- Dog owner understands that Seneca Pet Care's liability, of any circumstance related to the dog, will not exceed the current chattel value of a dog of the same breed as the one in our care.
- Due to the communal nature of our playgroups, and for safety/liability concerns, Seneca Pet Care does not allow any aggressive dogs for boarding or daycare.
- Pictures, recorded video, and live-stream video are included in services Seneca Pet Care LLC offers to dog owners. Additionally, they are an integral part of the security system in place at Seneca Pet Care LLC. They may be used for promotional purposes by display at the kennel or by inclusion on the website or other media. By leaving the pet in the care, custody, and control of Seneca Pet Care LLC, the owner consents to the dissemination of the pet's image unless otherwise noted in writing by the owner.

By submitting this form,

- a. You indicate your agreement with all the terms hereof.
- b. You acknowledge the risks of communal boarding. Dogs playing together in playgroups can sometimes result in injuries or spreading of such illnesses as Kennel Cough.
- c. You release, indemnify and hold Seneca Pet Care LLC harmless from any and all manner of damages, claims, losses, liabilities, costs or expenses, causes of action or suits, whatsoever in law or equity (including, without limitation, attorney's fees and related costs) arising out of or related to the services provided by Seneca Pet Care LLC, except which may arise from the sole gross negligence or intentional and willful misconduct of Seneca Pet Care LLC, including, without limitation: (i) any inaccuracy in any statement made by yourself or information provided by you to Seneca Pet Care LLC (ii) your dog, including but not limited to destruction of property, dog bites and transmission of disease, and (iii) any action by yourself which is in breach of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- d. This Agreement covers the current relationship between Seneca Pet Care LLC and yourself. Each time you bring your dog to Seneca Pet Care LLC, you affirm the terms of the Agreement and the truthfulness and accuracy of all statements you make in this Agreement.
